## CFC Golf Tournament Rules

1. The Team Competition is a "**4-PERSON SCRAMBLE**" event. 20% of total team handicap will be used.
2. Drive Format. Men play from white tees, and women play from red tees. All players tee off. Team selects the ball they wish to play and all players hit from that spot. Same format until the ball is holed out.
  - a. Teams must use minimum of 3 drives from each player.
  - b. You may clean and place the ball within one club length, no nearer the hole, from the spot of the selected ball.
  - c. You **MAY NOT** move the ball out of a water hazard, sand trap, from out of bounds to in bounds, or from off the green onto green.
  - d. You **MAY NOT** move from rough to fairway, or the fairway to rough.
  - e. For putting, place ball within six inches of the chosen spot no nearer the hole.
3. **Four Mulligans** maximum for purchase for each player. Mulligans can be used to replay any shot through the green with these stipulations:
  - a. Only the person having the mulligan can replay the shot.
  - b. If a mulligan is used, it must count as the ball in play (you can't use your first shot if the mulligan is worse).
  - c. Any # of players can use a Mulligan on any shot or hole, provided the player still has a mulligan.
  - d. A player may use all their Mulligans on one shot or hole.
4. The Team Competition consists of Low Gross and Low Net Scores.
5. Individual Competition: **Men and Women KP's and Long Drive.**
  - a. There is one Long Drive hole for both Men and Women. Long Drive must be first attempt and in the Fairway. Mulligans don't qualify.
  - b. There will be a KP (Closest-to-Pin) on a Par 3 hole for both Men and Women. KPs must be first attempt and on the green to count.
6. #9 Green is a single handed putt. Only one hand on the putter.
7. #6 Link is single club hole. Each player will select a single club that they will use to play the link from tee until the ball is on the green.
8. All Horseshoe Lake Golf Course rules and regulations must be followed.
  - a. Maintain Pace of Play. Keep pace with the group ahead.
  - b. Play "ready golf". Be ready to play when it is your turn.
  - c. Have FUN, be SAFE, and play QUICKLY.
